

# Custom Engraving Assembly Instructions

### Parts List



Custom Engraved Panel: 1 pc

Fits directly onto your display case by replacing one existing panel


3.97" X 3.97" X 5.90"(10cm X 10cm X 15cm) 7.87" X 7.87" X 11.81" (20cm X 20cm X 30cm) 11.81" X 11.81" X 17.72" (30cm X 30cm X 45cm)

#### Step 1: Assembly with Display Case

Complete the assembly of your display case step 3.1/3.2 of "Display Case Assembly Instructions" before proceeding.

> If you have the Display Case with the LED Base, remove the Display Case from the Base by lifting it up before proceeding

Each acrylic panel has a protective plastic/paper sheet on both sides to prevent damage.

Partially peel off the corners of the protective plastic on both sides sufficiently to allow the installation of the bracket and rivets.

Start removing from the corners.


#### Step 2.1: Disassembly of Display Case

Rivet

Acrylic Sheet

Remove

Side



Push

Bracket


Rotate the Display Case with the opening facing upwards as shown.

The Custom Engraved sheet can replace either the front or back panel of the Display Case. We recommend replacing the back panel.

\*Note that the front/back panel is larger than the side panels.


Remove the 4 rivets securing the font/back panel by pushing the centre of the rivets from the inside. Once completed, the front/back panel can be removed.

#### Step 3.1: Re-assembly of Display Case with Custom Engraved panel




Replace the front/back panel that you removed with the Custom Engraved panel before re-installing the 4 rivets.

Ensure the orientation of the Custom Engraved panel follows the orientation of the case.



Remove the remaining protective plastic/paper sheet on the panel before rotating the case back to it's correct orientation.



Place your figurine on the bottom panel/LED Base before placing the case over the figurine, ensuring that the case sits snugly with the bottom panel/LED Base.


#### Step 2.2: Disassembly of Display Case




Rotate the Display Case with the opening facing upwards as shown.

\*Note that the front/back panel is larger than the side panels.




#### Step 3.2: Re-assembly of Display Case with Custom Engraved panel




Replace the front/back panel that you removed with the Custom Engraved panel before re-installing the 6 rivets.

Ensure the orientation of the Custom Engraved panel follows the orientation of the case.



Remove the remaining protective plastic/paper sheet on the panel before rotating the case back to it's correct orientation.



Place your figurine on the bottom panel/LED Base before placing the case over the figurine, ensuring that the case sits snugly with the bottom panel/LED Base.
